(This is not a kit, you will be leaving with, but you should have in your home. Some of the items should be in your 72-ht kit)

Clothing, for wet and cold weather
Gloves, leather, work
Hat/cap
Jacket, warm
Pants, working (2 pair)
Rain coat or poncho

Sleeping bag or (sheets, blankets, pillows)
Tarp, for ground cover
Tent/shelter

Communication

Mirror, reflective
Flashlight
 extra batteries
Two-way radios (CB, GMRS, FRS, HAM, etc)
 extra batteries
Whistle, pea-less, non-metallic

Documents

Cash or travelers checks (small bills and some coin)
Documents, important (kept in a waterproof, portable container)
 Wills; insurance policies; contracts; deeds; passports;
 social security cards: bank account numbers, credit card
 account numbers and 1-800 numbers to cancel or ask questions:
 inventory of valuable household goods; family records (birth,
 marriage, death, immunization, etc) drivers license;
 insurance papers (home, vehicle life, etc)
Emergency contact list (w/ names address and phone numbers)
Maps, of area (routes out of area)
